



“WORLD WATER DAY & HERBAL HOLI

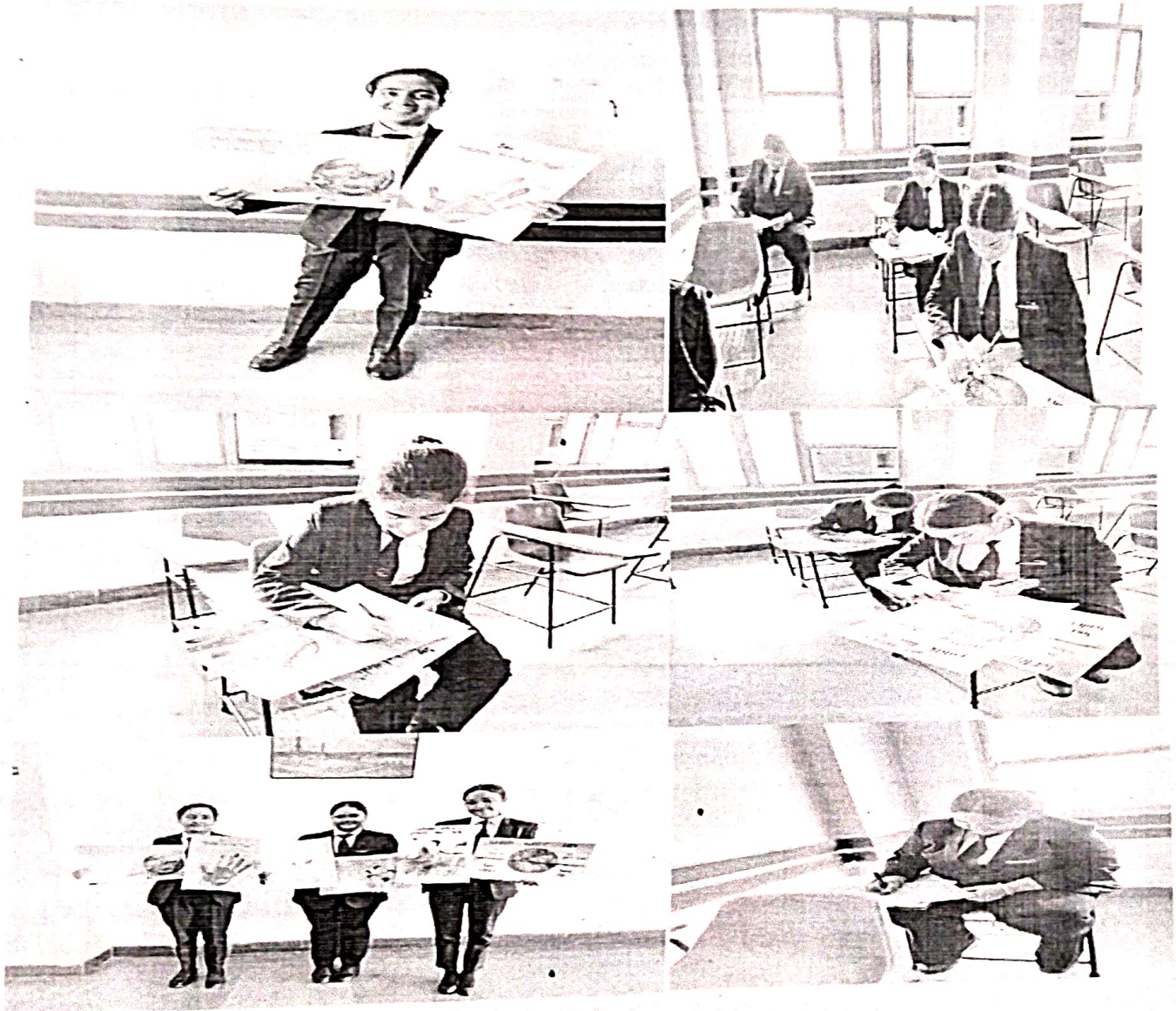

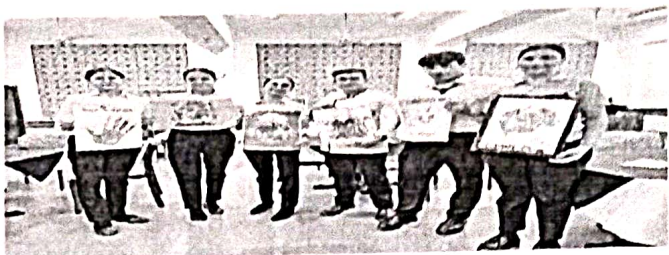
Event Write-up (Detailed Information):-

BCIHMCT celebrates International Yoga Day on June 21st

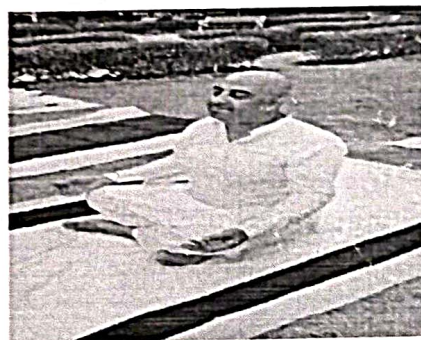
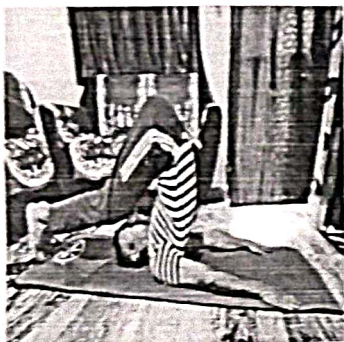
